



**2017 Lancaster National Speedway**

**Sportsman Division Tire Policy**

**TO ALL COMPETITORS/PARTICIPANTS**

**These procedures are a starting point and are subject to change at anytime**

- A) All teams will start the season with twelve (12) tire tickets on Opening Day.
- B) Four (4) of the twelve (12) tires purchased must be dedicated as spares. This is for cut tires or wrecks throughout the year.
- C) From week two (2), you get one (1) tire ticket per week. If you miss a week or weeks, you do not receive a ticket for that week. Each race you attend, you will be issued a tire ticket.
- D) Tire tickets will only be handed out at the drivers meeting.
- E) Each tire ticket will have the car number and drivers name on it, and will be signed by the Race Director and Driver.
- F) When turning in your tire tickets each week, each tire ticket **MUST** have the tire barcode number and stamped code legibly written on the tire ticket. This is to avoid teams from making their own barcode and help keep accurate records.
- G) There will be a tire ticket binder that has a page for each driver/car in which all tickets turned in will be recorded. This will be an open book to all competitors to keep everyone honest.
- H) In the event a team switches drivers at any point in the season, the tires in the team owner's inventory must be used.
- I) There is no limit to tire tickets you can use per week. This means, as long as you have enough tickets, you can put on zero (0) to four (4) tires per week.
- J) If a driver/team comes in after week one (1), that driver/team only get four (4) tires too start and one (1) tire per week after that. This helps keep everyone on an even level.
- K) All tires must be purchased from the authorized Lancaster National Speedway Tire Distributor.
- L) Tire softening, tire number altering, and tire ticket swapping or any other manipulation of any kind **WILL** not be tolerated and **WILL** result in suspension and fine. Resulting suspension if caught will be minimum six (6) week suspension, up to one year from date of infraction and a fine as stated in the General Rulebook.
- M. This will be a **ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY**. Bottom Line: you get caught, You **WILL** be suspended for a minimum of six (6) weeks.
